Before Departure	Join Pre-Departure Information on Monday, August 9. Review the Flying to Canada requirements checklist	Book your government approved hotel for the first 3 nights in Canada. This does not apply to any traveller entering Canada after August 9, 2021 or to vaccinated travellers.	Submit pre-departure documents to RIE to receive Letter of Support for travel: - Flight itinerary - RIE Isolation form - Travel and Arrival Protocol Checklist form	Take an approved COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to departure in your home country. Book your COVID-19 test for after arrival at the Port of Entry if you are unvaccinated.	Download the ArriveCan app and provide necessary information 48 hours prior to departure.
At Port of Entry	Provide appropriate documents for entry and proof of vaccination.	Undergo arrival testing for COVID-19 if you are unvaccinated. Random testing will be done for vaccinated travellers.	Obtain a study permit at Immigration Canada office.	Take transportation (e.g. taxi, hotel shuttle) directly to approved isolation facility after leaving the airport.	
Isolation	Students travelling after August 9 and are fully vaccinated with approved vaccines at least 2 weeks prior to arrival may go directly to their homestay/accommodation. You do not need to quarantine or take an additional COVID-19 test upon arrival if travelling after August 9, 2021. Random COVID-19 testing may be done.				
				If symptomatic or receives positive test	Isolate. Follow direction from Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH). Upon approval from VCH, leave isolation
	Unvaccinated students 	Take a COVID-19 test on day 8 of isolation. REVIEW PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS	Receive negative test	Leave isolation on day 14 or upon approval from Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH)

Registration and ELL assessment	Take English Language Learning (ELL) assessment	Submit registration documents to RIE - Registration form - copy of Study Permit - copy of final report card (in English)	Upon completing registration and ELL assessment, go to school and receive class schedule.	<i>Students must complete isolation, ELL assessment, and registration before reporting to school on their first day. Students will not be allowed to start school until all requirements are met.</i>
