About Richmond

The Richmond School District in Metro Vancouver is an excellent location for students of all ages and language abilities to get a first class international education experience. The district includes 10 secondary and 38 elementary schools that educate over 21,000 Canadian students. Richmond is an academic leader in Canada and is rated as one of the most livable cities in the country.

Short Term And Group Program Options

The Richmond School District is an exceptional location for students wishing to learn English in a Canadian school environment. In Richmond, each student has the opportunity for a customized learning experience through our many short term program non-credit options for individuals and groups.

Canadian School Experience Program (1-4 Months)

Students that would like to immerse themselves in Canadian culture but do not wish to commit to a full semester or year can take our Canadian School Experience Program from 4 weeks to 4 months.

This program gives students the opportunity to study alongside Canadians and develop English in a natural learning environment. Students are given a full class schedule made up of regular credit courses such as math, physical education, art or music with appropriate English (ELL) support.

Students in this program are encouraged to join clubs or other events happening at the school during their stay to get the full Canadian experience.

DATES: Students can begin on Mondays starting October until May.

APPLICATION: Apply online through our website with proposed study dates

ACCOMMODATION: Students have the option of living in an RIE arranged homestay (ages 13 and up) or in privately arranged accommodation.



Customized Group Programs

We welcome groups throughout the academic year for partial or full immersion in our local schools.

FULL IMMERSION PROGRAM

This option allows students to take a full class schedule with Canadian students. Students will be given regular classes, such as math, chemistry, physical education, photography or drama and placed in various schools throughout the district.

PARTIAL IMMERSION PROGRAM

In this option, students will benefit from language instruction in a closed classroom and have the opportunity to go into regular classes throughout the day to get a taste of a Canadian classroom. Students will all be placed at the same school. Group minimum: 15 students
